We will email the final schedule by the end of March to the email address provided above. At that point, you will have to confirm your testing with us and order the test forms for your student(s) right away in order to avoid rush fees later.**

I, the undersigned father/mother/legal guardian, agree to the following stipulations:

I would like for my student to be tested using the achievement test indicated above. I understand that the testing will take several days and will be done at the Homeschool Hangout facility in Alpharetta. My student is in good health and is able to participate in group testing. There are no known health issues that the Homeschool Hangout needs to take into consideration. I will stay on the premise during testing. Should I decide to leave the premise, I will not hold the Homeschool Hangout liable for any accidents or emergencies.

During test time I can be reached at this phone # \_\_\_\_\_. I understand that the achievement test is not a pass/fail test and I will not hold the Homeschool Hangout responsible for my student's test scores.

We will respect and abide by the following rules:

- Females: Please dress neatly and modestly. Clothing items that should not be worn include tight clothing, tank tops, camisoles, cropped shirts, low cut t-shirts and dresses, mini-skirts, low-ride pants, short shorts, and any apparel that exposes the back, midriff, or is otherwise distracting.
- Males: Please dress neatly and modestly. Clothing items that should not be worn are low riding pants and sloppy, torn or extremely oversized clothes.
- The dress code is subject to the discretion of the store management and the teachers/testing proctors. No refunds or make-up days will be offered students who do not abide by the rules.
- Students may not bring weapons, alcohol, drugs or tobacco products to class.

**FEES:** The HSH charges \$65 (group price, no tax) for administering the basic test battery and \$20 for each additional test (i.e. OLSAT or CogAT or Algebra Aptitude Test). All fees are due 1<sup>st</sup> day of testing. If we don't have at least 3 students in your student's age group we will contact you and offer you individual testing for \$120 administration fee and you can at that point accept or decline our offer to test your student. **Should your student miss any scheduled test time for whatever reason, a \$30 fee will be charged for each make-up session.**

**Ordering your Test Forms:** Parents order and pay for the test forms themselves by contacting BJU Testing & Evaluation at **1.800.845.5731** (BJU will charge about \$44 for the basic test and about \$20 for the CogAT or OLSAT or Algebra Aptitude Test).
